PRINCIPAL Message

Greetings from Finland Oman School, It has been a fun and challenging first term for me as a principal. I feel fortunate to be the Principal of Finland Oman School with such wonderful students, and motivated and dedicated staff members. We have continued to learn through a wide variety of innovative and collaborative methods and activities. There are always so many things going on, and I am sure that at times, it must be challenging to keep up with us. Therefore, we have decided to publish a newsletter three times during the academic year, so you as parents will have a chance to find out what has been going on at our school. We hope you enjoy reading it. Thank you to those of you who answered our two surveys. One of the surveys was about international trips, and we received 100 responses. Of those responses, 92% of parents said that they would like their child to travel abroad. In addition, 38% think the best time for the trip is in the summer, with 31% preferring the spring break. 82% would like the duration of the trip to be for 1 week and only 16 parents prefer two weeks. There were different destinations mentioned for an

international trip, however, Finland received the highest percentage of votes compared to other destinations. As 73% said that Finland would be the preferred destination, we have already started to plan for a trip to Finland with our Grade 11 students. We are excited to have our students experience this, and it has been decided that students in Grade 7 and above will also have the opportunity to travel. You will receive more information about the trip later on. We have also been working on developing our canteen with students and parents. Thank you to all who answered our survey. In total, 62 parents responded, and more than 60% of parents said they were satisfied with the breakfast and lunch that is provided for their child. 40% of parents provided us with suggestions to develop our canteen services, and as a result, we are working in cooperation with the catering company to make improvements. Your child's education and well-being are our top priority. We will continue collaborating with you to make your child's academic year a positive one.



FOS science lab is where students discover their passion for knowledge and creativity, whether in Biology, Physics, or Chemistry lessons; students of all ages enjoy experimenting and learning about science with enthusiasm. Our students start using the science lab regularly from grade 5 onwards, and our little talented scientists have joined the Science Club, where they meet once a week to build their scientific skills and make things such us rose perfume, catapult, nebula jar, balloon car, or a blood model. FOS Science labs are well-equipped, ensuring that students have the effective resources they need.





Studying about plants is always interesting, especially if you take a close look at the internal structure of a leaf. Students had a pleasant time while working in groups to build the structure of a leaf. Well done Grade 8! Science presentations and model making provide a platform for students to use their scientific knowledge and their artistic skills to promote their understanding, imagination and creativity. It enhances their speaking skills and self-esteem. In Grade 9, students prepared models of Eukaryotic and Prokaryotic cells and discussed the functions of the organelles inside each type of cells.

The role of the Drama Club is to give students a space of learning based on role-playing as a learning strategy and lifestyle, from expressing their feelings to role-playing for acting, miming scenes and quoting. GO GREEN TEAM

On Monday October 31st, F.O.S. students celebrated the Omani Tree Day. The celebration is considered as an affirmation for the importance of different kinds of trees and the fact that Omanis are closely linked to trees since old ages. Each student had a leaf template on which he/she wrote their thoughts about various topics related to trees such as: how does tree planting help wildlife, what are the names of some trees in Oman, what is the meaning of perennial trees or how trees can save us from global warming. Currently, students are collecting plastic lids bottles for the "Collect and Win" competition. These lids will be used to create a mural of the school logo.
