Early Arrival at School

Our school day starts at 7:30am. Yet we are able to start receiving students earlier, from 7.00 am.

Our staff members start arriving as early as 7:00 am, that's the official time for student monitoring in premises.

- A student's birthday can be acknowledged by their peers singing them the Happy Birthday song, and wearing a birthday badge/sticker for the school day



Mobile Phones at School

In our ever-changing world it is vital that students have access to technology, we here at FOS believe that the skills needed to navigate within 4IR can be taught throughout a student's schooling experience.
