After School Activities

After school activities will start from the week beginning October 27th. Dismissal Time

Please note that the school day ends at 2:30 pm, kindly ensure that your son/daughter is picked up on time. In order to collect your child at the end of the school day, you will need to personally enter the school building and pick up your son/daughter from the entrance area. In addition, please ensure the entrance doors are kept clear, and no cars are parked there, as we need to all comply with the health and safety regulations, as safety is our main priority.

Student ID Cards

We would like to remind students to bring in their ID cards every day. It is important for students to come to school with their ID cards as monitoring their attendance is done via the check in and check out of their cards.

Lost Property

We expect all students to have their uniforms and personal belonging labelled with their names using laundry marker pen or permanent marker pen.
